NOTES:

- 1. This form should be completed and signed by the prospective Mortgagee.
- When completed, it should be forwarded, along with the appropriate fee, to DGCAR, Flight Safety Department, P.O. Box 1, Code 111, Muscat, Sultanate of Oman.
- 3. If the proposed mortgage covers more than one aircraft, a separate entry should be made against each aircraft.
- 4. The DGCAR will confirm an entry in the Mortgage Register by returning a photocopy of the relevant entry to all parties named overleaf and to the current registered owner.
- 5. Once accepted, a Priority Notice is valid for fourteen working days including the date of entry. To maintain priority, the contemplated mortgage must be made and entered in the Mortgage Register, or a further Priority Notice entered, within the fourteen day period.
